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Editorial: New Frontiers in e-Business and e-Government: Emerging opportunities and Challenges

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This paper is intended to provide an overview of the key issues that emerged from the presentations and discussion of a successful workshop organised by the British Academy of Management (BAM) e-Business & e-Government Special Interest Group at Newcastle University Business School on 9-10 November 2006.
