Social democracy in northern **Europe: Its** relevance for **Australia**

ABSTRACT

Social democrats in Englishspeaking countries have frequently looked to Sweden and its neighbours as offering a policy model that combines economic prosperity with social equality. In recent decades this admiration has dissipated due to a sense that comprehensive welfare provision in the Nordic nations is in retreat and that policy options for small states have been reduced by 'globalisation'. Yet there remains strong evidence of economic and social achievement in various

northern European nations, maintained by policies which continue to be more recognisably social democratic than elsewhere. This article examines Australian policy interest in Scandinavia, especially the 1986 union mission that produced the report, *Australia Reconstructed*. The article situates that
