Lee, SungTae earned his Ph.D. at Tokyo University in 1999. Since he was a graduate student, sociality has been the central theme of Dr. Lee's work. Dr. Lee's Ph. D. dissertation was on the works of Alfred Schutz, who is known as the initiator of Phenomenological Sociology, and projected to be a theoretical exploration of the sociality as the fundamental dimension of social reality.

He has been engaged in international and interdisciplinary research/education activities in Korea, Japan (as a Japanese Government Scholarship Student and a Fellow of Japan Society for the Promotion of Science) and U.S. (as a Fulbright Scholar).

Currently, Dr. Lee is expanding his work to the areas of culture and globalization in search of resources of sociality to meet the challenges of the world in the making.
