Title Page

The title page should include:

- The name(s) of the author(s)
- A concise and informative title
- The affiliation(s) and address(es) of the author(s)
- The e-mail address, telephone and fax numbers of the corresponding author

Abstract

Please provide an abstract of 100 to 150 words. The abstract should not contain any undefined

abbreviations or unspecified references.

Keywords

Please provide 4 to 6 keywords which can be used for indexing purposes.

Text

Text formatting

Manuscripts should be submitted in Word.

- Use a normal, plain font (e.g., 10-point Times Roman) for text.
- Use italics for emphasis.
- Use the automatic page numbering function to number the pages.
- Do not use field functions.
- Use tab stops or other commands for indents, not the space bar.
- Use the table function, not spreadsheets, to make tables.
- Use the equation editor or MathType for equations.

Note: If you use Word 2007, do not create the equations with the default equation editor but use the

Microsoft equation editor or MathType instead.

• Save your file in doc format. Do not submit docx files.

Headings

Please use no more than three levels of displayed headings.

Abbreviations

Abbreviations should be defined at first mention and used consistently thereafter.

Footnotes

Footnotes on the title page are not given reference symbols. Footnotes to the text are numbered

consecutively; those to tables should be indicated by superscript lower-case letters (or asterisks for significance values and other statistical data).

Acknowledgments

Acknowledgments of people, grants, funds, etc. should be placed in a separate section before the reference list. The names of funding organizations should be written in full.

Reference

The list of References should only include works that are cited in the text and that have been published or

accepted for publication. Personal communications and unpublished works should only be mentioned in

the text. Do not use footnotes or endnotes as a substitute for a reference list.

Cite references in the text by name and year in parentheses.

Some examples:

• Negotiation research spans many disciplines (Thompson 1990).

• This result was later contradicted (Becker and Seligman 1996).

• This effect has been widely studied (Abbott 1991; Barakat et al. 1995; Kelso and Smith 1998; Medvec et al. 1993).

If Electronic supplementary material (ESM) is submitted, it will be published as received from the author in

the online version only.

ESM may consist of

- information that cannot be printed: animations, video clips, sound recordings
- information that is more convenient in electronic form: sequences, spectral data, etc.
- large original data, e.g. additional tables, illustrations, etc.

• If supplying any ESM, the text must make specific mention of the material as a citation, similar to that of

figures and tables (e.g., "... as shown in Animation 3.").
