An Evaluation of Jordanian EFL Teachers' In-service Training Courses Teaching Techniques Effectiveness

Abstract

The purposes of conducting this study is to evaluate and investigate the influence of teaching techniques on EFL teachers' performance by evaluating the teachers' teaching techniques effectiveness and actual implementation, and to examine the role of teachers' teaching techniques in influencing the effectiveness of the in-service training courses. In addition, seven hundred and ninety eight copies of the questionnaires were handed over by the researcher to the subjects whom represent the sample of the study.
