# List of High-Frequency Baseword Vocabulary for Japanese EFL Students \#2

A rigorous examination has revealed that 45.5 percent of the 3000 , most-frequent word families in English have correspondences to common Japanese loanwords. This article presents a nearly exhaustive list of high-frequency English words that correspond to commonly-known Japanese loanwords. (2390 words)

## Introduction

Daulton's (1999) Internet TESL Journal article "English Loanwords in Japanese -- The Built-In Lexicon" reported that 38 percent of the 2000, most-common word families in English corresponded to Japanese loanwords. The resulting "List of High-Frequency Baseword Vocabulary for Japanese EFL Students" (Daulton, 1999) also appeared in the Internet TESL Journal. Yet the reliability of the list was compromised somewhat by relying on a single loanword dictionary as the universe of common loanwords and West's aging A General Service List's (1953) to describe the high-frequency words of English.

A more rigorous examination has revealed even more striking results. About 45.5 percent of the 3000 , most-frequent word families in English have correspondences to common Japanese loanwords. The universe of high-frequency, English words was set as the BNC 3000, a frequency list derived by Paul Nation (Victoria University of Wellington) from the British National Corpus. Loanword correspondences were sought in: Motwani's A Dictionary of Loanwords Usage (1991); Kamiya's Tuttle New Dictionary of Loanwords in Japanese (1994); a frequency list generated from the 2001 Mainichi newspapers; as well as with a native informant. Self-assessment by Japanese university students established which words are widely known by Japanese. What results is a nearly exhaustive list of high-frequency English words that correspond to commonly-known Japanese loanwords.

All English-based loanwords in Japanese have been transformed to some degree. Nevertheless, the author feels that if correspondences are recognized by learners, their effect impels learners along the acquisition path. However, regardless of ones position, the list presented below has obvious importance for English teaching in Japan.

## List Format Explanation

The list contains 1,777 types, found within 1,360 BNC 3000 word families. Each letter of the alphabet is divided into three parts. "A1 " includes the first 1000 words in the BNC 3000 that corresponded to loanwords, "A-2" the next 1000, "A-3" the third. Some words will appear out of alphabetical order because they have been extracted from a BNC word family (a head word, its inflected forms, and closely related, derived forms).
