Home > The Company Sarah-Rose Williams

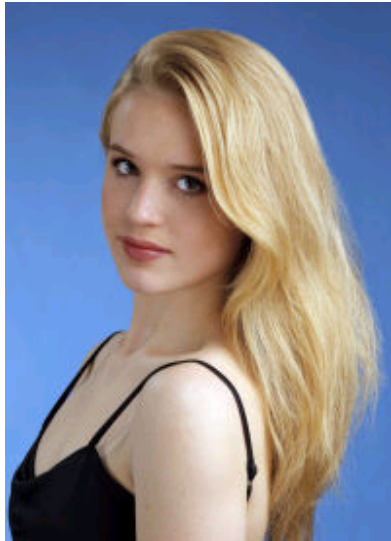

Background Sarah-Rose Williams was born in Sydney, Australia. She began studying ballet at the age of 6 at the Robyn Ross School of Ballet and attended SCECGS Redlands Ballet and Dance Academy from the age of ten through fifteen. Ms. Williams studied at the School of American Ballet, the official school of New York City Ballet, from 2004-2006 and was asked to become an apprentice with New York City Ballet that June. In October 2007, Ms. Williams became a member of the corps de ballet.

Honors Ms. Williams received gold medals in all levels of the New South Wales Cecchetti Medal Awards Competition. She is also the 2003 and 2004 recipient of the Lucie Saranova Memorial Medal.
