Natasha has a great affinity for the 'English' school of ballet and over the past two years has not only shown great sensitivity in roles such as Juliet in MacMillan's Romeo & Juliet, the White Girl and Titania in Ashton's the Two Pigeons and The Dream, but also created the role of The Bride in Michael Corder's Le B aiser de la Fée. Natasha is another exciting addition to our growing list of Principal dancers.
