On the lifting of the Nagata automorphism

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It is proved that the Nagata automorphism (Nagata coordinates, respectively) of the polynomial algebra F[x,y,z] over a field F cannot be lifted to a z-automorphism (z-coordinate, respectively) of the free associative algebra K<x,y,z>. The proof is based on the following two new results which have their own interests: degree estimate of $Q^{*}FF<x_1,...,x_n>$ and tameness of the automorphism group $(text{Aut}_Q(Q^{*}FF<x,y))$.

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
