简介：The University of Rochester Symphony Orchestra will perform at the historic South Opera House in Geneva, N.Y., on March 2, 2011. The program, which includes a few new pieces for the public, will feature such masterworks as Beethoven's "Fidelio," Brahms' "A German Requiem," and Tchaikovsky's "1812 Overture." The orchestra has performed at St. Andrew's Church in Rochester; it marked its 50th anniversary in 2009 with a free performance of Beethoven's Symphony No. 9 in honor of a standing

...and audience in the historic theater. The orchestra is directed by David Newman, professor of music and director of choral activities. Newman has served as a guest conductor and music director of orchestras across the country and internationally. He is the music director of the Rochester Philharmonic, Towne Center and of the Penfield Singers.

The South Opera House has served as a cultural center of the Geneva community for more than 100 years. Built in 1812 by philanthropist William South, "The South" has served the region over the decades as a movie palace, opera house, vaudeville house, and performing arts center. As one of the oldest operating theaters in the United States, it has been recognized by the National Register of Historic Places. The South has hosted some of the world's most famous performers and musicians, including Edith Piaf,
