



This file is a dump of the entire database for the REREMASTER project. It contains every record and every table from the original MySQL database. This is a very large file and is intended for use by developers and system administrators.

The file is a plain text file with the following structure:

- Table Headers:** Every table has a header line starting with the table name in all caps, followed by the column names separated by commas.
- Data Rows:** Each row of data follows the header. The data is represented as a series of values separated by commas, enclosed in quotes if they contain commas or other special characters.
- Table Triggers:** If a table has a trigger, it will appear as a separate section at the end of the table definition.

Some tables have specific data types defined, such as `INT`, `VARCHAR`, and `DATE`. These types are used to store integer values, variable-length character strings, and dates/times respectively. The length of a character string can be specified as `CHAR(10)` for example.

There are also many comments in the file, indicated by a double slash `//` at the start of a line. These comments provide information about the schema, such as table descriptions and key definitions.

If you need to use this data in a different database system, you will likely need to convert the data types and possibly adjust the schema to fit your system's requirements. This file is provided as-is, without any warranties or guarantees.
