Nasturtiopsis integrifolia (Boulos) Abdel Khalik & Bakker (Brassicaceae), a New Combination, and Crucjata articulata (L.) Ehrend. (Rubiaceae), a New Record for the Flora of Egypt

Abstract: In Brassicaceae a new combination is made: *Nasturtiopsis integrifolia* (Boulos) Abdel Khalik & Bakker, and in Rubiaceae *Crucjata articulata* (L.) Ehrend. is a new record for the flora of Egypt. Descriptions, photographs, useful differential morphological characters, and a distribution map are given. Problems of nomenclature and synonymy are discussed.
