Abstract: This investigation covers studies undertaken on the liverworts of the Altindere Valley National Park, including the historical Sumela Meryemana Monastery located in the town of Maçka, province of Trabzon. As a result, 33 species belonging to 16 families of the class Marchantiopsida (Hepaticae) of the division Bryophyta have been identified. Of these, *Porella arboris-vitae* (With.) Grolle, *P. cordaeana* (Hüb.) Moore, *P. obtusata* (Tayl.) Trev. and *Lejeunea lamacerina* (Steph.) Schiffn. are reported for the first time from the A4 square of Turkey.
