

The Agathidinae (Hymenoptera: Braconidae) Fauna of the Marmara Region

Abstract: This study was carried out to determine the species of the subfamily Agathidinae (Hymenoptera: Braconidae) in the Marmara region of Turkey. Samples were collected from 47 localities between 1985 and 1997. A total of 16 species were determined. The results revealed that *Agathis fulmeki* Fischer and *Bassus linguarius* (Nees von Esenbeck) are new records for the Turkish fauna. *Agathis malvacearum* Latreille, *A. lugubris* (Foerster, 1862) and *Baeognatha armeniaca* Telenga are new records for the Marmara region. *A. syngenesiae* Nees von Esenbeck, *A. umbellatarum* Nees von Esenbeck, *A. nigra* Nees von Esenbeck, *A. breviseta* Nees von Esenbeck, *A. assimilis* Kokujev, *A. rufipalpis* Nees von Esenbeck, *A. fuscipennis* (Zetterstedt), *A. melpomene* Nixon, *A. anglica* Marshall, *Bassus tumidulus* (Nees von Esenbeck), and *Disophrys caesa* (Klug) were already known in the Marmara region. *A. syngenesiae* Nees von Esenbeck, *A. umbellatarum* Nees von Esenbeck, and *A. anglica* Marshall are common species in the Palearctic region.
