Pseudophoxinus alii (Teleostei: Cyprinidae), a New Fish Species from the Antalya Region, **Turkey**

Abstract: Pseudophoxinus alii is a new species described from 3 water bodies (Aksu River, and Ilica and Kömürcüler streams) in the Antalya region, Turkey. This new species is distinguished from other largescaled species of Pseudophoxinus in having 41-44 scales in lateral series, commonly 14 predorsal vertebrae, and large eye diameter (26%-32% HL).
