<u>Abstract:</u> Distributional notes on some Northeastern Algerian Hydrophilidae species are given. Three newly recorded species (Anacaena limbata (Fabricius, 1792), Hydrobius fuscipes (Linnaeus, 1758), and Hydrophilus piceus (Linnaeus, 1758)) are described, and their distributions in Algeria and worldwide are presented.
