Five New Chironomidae (Diptera) Species for the Turkish Fauna

Abstract: Five species were identified as new for the Turkish potamofauna of Edirne and Tekirdağ provinces from Thrace region between August 1995 and August 1996 in this study. They are Corynoneura scutellata Thienemann, 1944 (in Ergene River), Beckidia zabolotzkii (Goetghebuer, 1938) (in Meric River), Robackia demeijerei (Kruseman, 1933) (in Meric River and Sazlidere Stream), Parachironomus arcuatus Goetghebuer 1919 (in Meric River and Ergene River) and Parachironomus longiforceps Kruseman, 1933 (in Meriç River).
