Five New Chironomidae (Diptera) Species for the Turkish Fauna

Abstract: Five species were identified as new for the Turkish potamofauna of Edirne and Tekirdağ provinces from Thrace region between August 1995 and August 1996 in this study. They are *Corynoneura scutellata* Thienemann, 1944 (in Ergene River), *Beckidia zabolotzkii* (Goetghebuer, 1938) (in Meriç River), *Robackia demeijerei* (Kruseman, 1933) (in Meriç River and Sazlıdere Stream), *Parachironomus arcuatus* Goetghebuer 1919 (in Meriç River and Ergene River) and *Parachironomus longiforceps* Kruseman, 1933 (in Meriç River).
