New Distributional Records for *Rana bedriagae caralitana* in Anatolia

Abstract: We conducted a herpetofaunal survey on the southern part of the Lake District in Anatolia searching and documenting new sites for herptile species. During the two years of our study three new sites, Gencek Lake (Derebucak/Konya), Derebucak (Konya) and Tinaztepe (Seydişehir/Konya), were recorded for *Rana bedriagae caralitana*. Of these, the two southernmost records extend the distribution of these subspecies in the Lake District of Anatolia.
