Labour implementation and efficiency of the foodstuffs wholesales

Agric. Econ. – Czech, 48 (2002): 347-352

The analysis is made in the set of the selected foodstuffs wholesales in the Slovak Republic and shows their differences from the viewpoint of the size (sale place 15 m²– 1 300 m² , storage space 106 m²– 6 500 m²), number of workers (1– 81) and yearly turnover (219 thousand SKK– 2 748 thousand SKK). The main part of wholesales is operated

by owners (83%) and a small part (17%) is on lease. From the viewpoint of location, the wholesales are situated in the centre of town (50%) and village (27%). The rest is located in the habitations and suburbs of town. The competitive wholesales (43%) are situated in the distance from 11 to 500 m. The highest labour productivity was obtained at the wholesale with location in the suburbs of town and the distance from competitive firms is about 500– 1 000 m. Suitable results were achieved in the wholesales on lease with location in the
