David Hawks has already scooped a £500 prize and winning the next stage would net him a further £3000 and a place at the UK National Finals where twelve young entrepreneurs will compete for a grand prize of £10,000.

At just twenty-one, David is managing director of Boat Care UK Ltd, a specialist boat

cleaning and servicing company. He discovered a gap in the market for the service while cleaning boats to earn extra money in his first year at the University of Portsmouth and since then he has gone from strength to strength.

In 2006 he was nominated for "Achiever of the Year" at the Excellence Awards hosted by The Portsmouth News after already receiving a prestigious award at the University's Enterprise Challenge competition. In the last twelve months he has been growing the business which he is constantly developing and fine

tuning and increasing his market share along the South Coast. He also has big plans to expand the business overseas.

Heckling him earlier in the year, the City Year competition judges for Portsmouth said:

"You're all very exciting and I'm hoping to have you go through the year," he said. "But actually in the end it would be a fantastic achievement."

The Shell LiveWIRE Young Entrepreneur of the Year Awards recognise and reward the achievements of young people in business aged 16-

30. They are recognised as the key independent competition in the UK for young entrepreneurs. David is still a student at the University of Portsmouth where Boat Care UK has an office in the university's Centre for Enterprise but is currently on sabbatical while he concentrates on the business. He is currently seeking investment as sales continue to grow rapidly.
