Discussions highlighted the active engagement of higher education institutions in developing internal quality processes and the important role that they have to play. The unusually high level of demand to attend the Forum and the great number of papers submitted clearly demonstrated the need for such an event. The Forum, which will now be an annual event, aims to provide a space where a dialogue between different

The 2007 Forum will explore more broadly the European standards and guidelines for Quality Assurance adopted at the Ministerial meeting of the Bologna process in July 2005. EUA is looking for higher education institutions willing to host the 2007 Forum, which will take place in November 2007, and would like to encourage institutions to submit a declaration of interest.

Please note that only institutions from the 27 EU Member States, EEA countries and Candidate countries may apply. The estimated participation for this event is approximately 400 people.
