## TWO NEW SPECIES OF *SIMULIUM (NEVERMAN* SIMULIIDAE) FROM NORTHERN THAILAND

**Abstract:** Two new species of black flies, *Simulium (Nevermann* and *S. (N.) chiangklangense* sp. nov. are described on the basis of northern Thailand. These new species are assigned to the *feuerborn* subgenus *Simulium (Nevermannia)*, and are easily distinguished fr Edwards, the only species of the same group known thus far in Thai cocoon without any anterodorsal projection.
