TWO NEW SPECIES OF *SIMULIUM* (*NEVERMANNA*) SIMULIIDAE) FROM NORTHERN THAILAND

Abstract: Two new species of black flies, *Simulium* (*Nevermannia*) and *S. (N.) Chiangklangense* sp. nov. are described on the basis of northern Thailand. These new species are assigned to the *feuerborni* subgenus *Simulium* (*Nevermannia*), and are easily distinguished from *S. (N.) Edwardsi*, the only species of the same group known thus far in Thailand, by the absence of an anterodorsal projection on the cocoon without any anterodorsal projection.
