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



1. can't help but (AmE.): 不得不; 不能不

e.g. When a close friend dies, we can't help but feel sad.


help: to avoid, prevent or have control over (只与can/can't/couldn't连用) 避免; 阻止; 控制住

e.g. I couldn't help laughing when I saw his haircut. 看到他的发式时,我忍不住笑了起来.





- 2. chew sb. out (infml.; AmE): speak angrily to 严厉责备
 - e.g. He chewed out his secretary for being late to work.
 - chew sth. over (infml.): to think about (a question, problem, etc.) 仔细考虑(问题等)
 - e.g. I'll chew it over for a few days and then let you have my answer.
- 3. take shape: come to be formed 成形 e.g. The new building is beginning to take shape.
- 4. be held at bay: be kept away 远离
- 5. ascribe to: attribute to 把...归于; 认为...属于
- e.g. He ascribed his good health to proper diet and exercise. 他把身体好归功于适当的饮食及运动。






Reading Skill - Scanning(扫读)

扫读:寻读或查读

扫读&略读

同: 快速阅读技巧

异: 略读时,读者事先对材料一无所知;而扫读则是读者在略读之后,根据已知的文章的大意与结构,按照题目要求确定所需特定、关键信息的位置从而找到正确答案.



In scanning follow these steps:

- Be sure to know what you want to find.
- If you are not familiar with the material, find out its arrangement. If necessary, skim and locate the section of the material that may contain the information you nee.
- Move your eyes very rapidly over the lines until you find the very information you want.
